Apra is proud to announce that **Meadow Fallon, Manager, Prospect Research at Environmental Defense Fund**, has been selected as the recipient of the **2026 Margaret Fuhry Award**, funded by the Apra Foundation. The award recognizes an Apra member whose exceptional leadership, mentorship, and volunteer service have strengthened the prospect development profession and inspired colleagues across the field.

Throughout her career, Meadow has distinguished herself as an innovative prospect development professional, dedicated mentor, and generous volunteer. Her work combines strategic prospect research, relationship mapping, and pipeline management with a passion for helping others learn, grow, and succeed.

At the Environmental Defense Fund, Meadow has become known for her ability to develop scalable processes that strengthen both prospect development and frontline fundraising. In less than three years in her current role, she has led high-profile initiatives, created innovative prospecting models, refined executive briefing systems, and developed forward-looking tools that connect research insights directly to fundraising strategy.

Beyond her organization, Meadow has made a significant impact through her volunteer leadership with Apra Pennsylvania and the broader Apra community. As a former Chapter Secretary and frequent conference presenter, she has shared her expertise on topics ranging from relationship building and Form 990 analysis to ethics and strategic prospecting. She is recognized as a collaborative leader who understands the importance of bringing professionals together to share ideas, develop best practices, and strengthen the profession.
